## FILM PICK OF THE WEEK II CA WENKY"

FIRE EYES

This debut film from Somalian director Soraya Mire is the second decomentary about female genital matilation to appear in the last year. Senital matilation, often euphemistically referred to as "circumcision." Is a practice commospiace in Africa, the Middle East and other parts of the world (including the U.S.) in which the etitoria and lable of young girls are lopped off and the wounds sustained that. Gompared to Warrior Marka, from starrituck director Pratible Perman, Five Eyes is a marvel of balance and intensity, Mire's film, 12 years in the making, combines a rigorous analysis of the forcias that fuel the mutilations with a comprehensive report on the educational movement afoot to set the practice (while providing a caustionary rejeinder to Western warmen who may lack sensitivity in their tullying approach to the issue). Interviews with servivors of the ritual rite of passage are cut with commontary from those who support the ongoing tradition. Throughout the doc, and in first travels acount for country top promote it, Mire — who currently lives in Los Angules — is a fierce advocate for the abolition of a practice she confiscingly describes as both psychologically and physically mutilating, the utilizate oldid abuse." Of hir own experience undergoing the procedure at ago 13, Mire writes, "I knew what he was doing to me . . . I shways will bear the sound of the sciasors cutting the flesh between my logs. The pain was horrondous. I struggled to get away, but was held down by three people, including my mother." Trage, uplifting smart. (Sunset 5; Fri.-Thurs., Aug. 10-25, I p.m.)
